Keeping Your Home Safe- During a Vacation

With spring break coming up here are five tips to keep your home safe while you're away.

- 1) Make your home appear occupied.
i.e. Add timers to lights and television sets.
- 2) Open some of the drapes or blinds on your windows. This helps keep lights inside your home more visible.
- 3) Disconnect your automatic garage door openers. Sometimes they malfunction and the door will open by itself.
- 4) Have your mail and newspaper held, or picked up by a friend or neighbor.
- 5) Call the Goddard Police Department (316-794-2051) and request a vacation home watch form for extra security while you are away.

The Goddard Police Department is committed to keep you safe, even when you are away. If you are going away for spring break make sure to take these precautions, so you do not have to worry while you are away.
