

Police Report Fees

The following fees for copies of police reports are effective February 4, 2019.

Offense Report (Public record information only) - \$10.00

Accident Reports - \$10.00

Attorney Request for records (Signed motion for production of records) - \$10.00

Police Videos (will be provided via a cloudshare email) - \$30.00 per incident

Archive Search - \$25.00/hr, minimum 1 hr.

All fees must be paid at time of request. Requests must be made in person or in writing to the Police Clerk at 118 North Main, Goddard, KS 67052. Anything other than public information requires a court order. Dates of birth, social security and driver's license numbers will be redacted to protect privacy on public record information. Records will be available within 2-10 working days of the incident. Redacted videos can result in additional fees.

FINGERPRINT SERVICES: \$20.00

Accommodations will be met based on staffing levels and must be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance. Please call 316-794-2051 between 8:00a.m. and 4:00p.m. and ask for the Police Clerk or Captain Beagley to schedule an appointment.

What You Need to Bring

- Fingerprint card(s) - we carry FBI FD-258 cards (included in fee)
- Fee of \$20.00
- Government proof of identification (i.e. driver's license, Kansas ID, or passport).
