Street Construction Cones

As a reminder, please never drive on areas of roads or streets that are coned off. In the coming months, the City of Goddard will be contracting roadway repairs in numerous subdivisions and areas of the city. If a stretch of a street is blocked by cones, please do not drive through that area. Driving on fresh asphalt or road sealant can damage the surface and even require the process to be started over. If one side of a street is blocked off, please be patient and drive around the construction.
