183rd Pathway Extension

On May 6, 2019 the City Council of Goddard approved the 183rd Street Sidewalk Improvement Bid and awarded the contract to Prado Construction. The project includes the installation of an eight-foot wide sidewalk beginning at the Holy Spirit Crosswalk south of U.S. 400 to the Prairie Sunset Trail along the western side of 183rd Street. Further, the project includes six benches, sidewalk ramps, and a retaining wall. Site cleaning and restoration were also included in the request.

The project aligns with the City of Goddard's mission to provide a family oriented, active lifestyle by increasing our neighbor's pedestrian access to services and amenities such as our parks and the Prairie Sunset Trail. Further, this project aligns with suggestions outlined within the City's Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan.

Turn Around, Don't Drown!

As a friendly reminder, never try to walk or drive through flooded roadways! Especially, please avoid areas with moving water. With the vast amount of rain this year, we want our neighbors to stay safe and avoid areas prone to flash flooding.



According to the National Weather Service, A mere 6 inches of fast-moving flood water can knock over an adult. It takes just 12 inches of rushing water to carry away a small car, while 2 feet of rushing water can carry away most vehicles. Please be safe and smart when navigating flooded areas!

With all the hail landing over this storm season, the City of Goddard wants to remind everyone to have your contractor pull a roofing permit if roofing work is going to be done. This allows the City to check the roofing license of each contractor to verify they are in good standing with the state of Kansas.
