

Recreational Vehicle Storage

The City would like to remind everyone that Boats/RVs/ Campers can only be in the driveway and front yard for a maximum of 15 days. If it is located on the street adjacent to the property it can only remain there for 48 hours. At no point can any RV be placed in such a way as to block the sidewalk, which is for pedestrian use.

All Boats/ RVs/Campers must be stored for the winter behind the house or on the side of the house out of the front yard and driveway which faces the street. If this cannot be accomplished, it must be stored in private storage off of the residential lot. For questions related to this requirement please see Article 6 of the Zoning and Subdivision Regulations.

This is to protect the safety and health of anyone walking or riding bikes along the City sidewalk that may be obscured from view by the RV. If there are any questions or concerns, feel free to call 316-794-2441 or email mccoggan@goddardks.gov

Save Some Time, Pay Online!

Police Department Speed Trailer

When driving around Goddard, neighbors might notice a small trailer on the side of the road that displays your speed as you drive by. The purpose of this is to track speeds of drivers around Goddard. Since our officers cannot be everywhere at once, it allows them to monitor traffic in different areas of town. As a result, officers can identify areas where they believe many cars are speeding. This is very important for streets with a heavy presence of children and pedestrians. The primary goal is to ensure the safety of all people in Goddard by accurately and ethically monitoring the speed of traffic. Goddard Gratitude

Recently, the Goddard Gratitude was awarded to the Goddard Walmart Manager, Curtis Koirth. In late spring, the Goddard Police Department began researching the possibility of purchasing an Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) for operational use. Officer Lamar became aware of a grant opportunity through Walmart and contacted store manager Curtis Koirth. The grant application was completed and within a week we were notified by Walmart Corporation that it had been sent to Curtis for approval at the store level. Only two weeks after our application, the Police Department received a check for \$2,500.00 to go toward our UAS. Curtis has been a great partner since transferring to the Goddard store and is committed to working with our officers to deter crime in our community. Thank you Curtis, for your unwavering passion and commitment to our Community!



Since purchasing the UAS, Officers Lamar and Keith have completed training and obtained their FAA Part 107 license and the PD has been approved for an FAA Certificate Of Authorization (COA) to operate the UAS as a government agency. The UAS has been deployed in training and had its first operational use last week following a WPD officer involved shooting and car chase.

Brush Pile

As a courtesy to our residents, the public works department operates a brush pile for tree limbs or brush on weekdays from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. during the summer and on the second Saturday each month from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. The pile is located at 1206 S. 199th St. W.

By law, the City cannot accept trash, boards, logs, or fencing of any kind. Please refrain from including any of these materials when utilizing the burn pile. To schedule an appointment, call the Public Works line at (316) 794-8992.
