## Summer Road Maintenance Schedule for Walnut Street rebuild, and information on street maintenance projects

Walnut Street Construction  
Schedule

Between 3<sup>rd</sup> and Kellogg

-June 30<sup>th</sup> -July 13<sup>th</sup>: excavation  
of street (side A)

-July 16<sup>th</sup> – July 29<sup>th</sup> : excavation  
of street (side B)

-July 31<sup>st</sup> – August 6<sup>th</sup> – Surface  
asphalt on top of base

Local traffic will be allowed to flow north toward Kellogg during construction on Walnut. If you have any question or concerns you can contact Kansas Paving at 316-832-0828.
